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How do you work with or lead a team?

As a team leader, I prioritize fostering a collaborative and empowering environment where each member feels valued and has a clear sense of purpose. Collaborative Environment: I foster an inclusive space where the executive board and chairs can openly share ideas, address concerns, and collaborate to bring initiatives to life.

Recognition: Through initiatives like the monthly spotlight member awards, I acknowledge the hard work and achievements of team members, creating a motivating atmosphere that encourages ongoing commitment.

These core values guide my leadership approach, and by consistently applying them, I have successfully cultivated a motivated, high-performing ASDA team this year.

What leadership experiences have equipped you for the role of President/Vice President?

Over the past three years in dental school, I have gained valuable leadership experience that has prepared me for the role of Vice President or President. Serving as ASDA President-elect, District 5 Director of Events, and currently as NSU ASDA President, I have developed a comprehensive skill set in team management, event planning, and strategic advocacy.

What are 2-3 issues important to dental students and/or the position of president?

I propose creating a mini advocacy series that highlights current issues in dentistry and provides a platform for dental students to engage in grassroots efforts to drive change. This initiative would empower students to advocate for policies that shape a better future for the profession post-graduation.

Finally, the rising cost of dental education and the increasing burden of student debt remain significant concerns. As ASDA National President, I would leverage the resources of National ASDA to advocate for policy changes that address the financial challenges students face. This includes promoting loan repayment options and other financial solutions to ensure that dental education becomes more affordable and accessible.

By addressing these key issues—conference accessibility, student advocacy, and debt management—I aim to support dental students in their professional development and ensure a sustainable, equitable future for the dental community.
